

Lascaux – July 4th, 2009

The early months of the Lascaux program have permitted to build - around a core of researchers from the university of Nantes and Nice - a team of about 80 researchers from fifteen countries. This team was able to meet in June 2009 in Nantes during an international conference on "Access to the land and its use: differing international approaches".

Meanwhile, three books have been launched: a commented code of European and international food law, a Treaty of European food law and an encyclopedic dictionary around the triptych "Law-Food-Land". The books are intended to give coherence to a body of law currently dispersed and to disseminate knowledge of law applicable to agri-food issues. It is now time to prepare scientific activities that will intend to increase the researches concerning the causes of problems relating to food and land issues.

This diagnostic work is essential if we want to identify the legal impediments to the resolution of these problems or which are otherwise necessary to overcome them. These activities will be presented soon on this website.
