Seminar on Law, sustainable development and food safety - Nantes, January 6th, 2012 :

International seminar on the EU external relations Law after the Lisbon Treaty on November 24th and 25th, 2011 :

Co-organized by Lascaux and the research laboratory Droit et Changement Social at the University of Nantes, this [colloquium](#) served as a meaningful reflection on the interest expressed and the place given by the European Union to the issues of sustainable and equitable development, fundamental rights and the need for access to food.

Doctoral seminar on fundamental rights and right to food - September 29th and 30th :

This seminar was led by Professor **Erping Li** ([Kunming University of Science and Technology](#), China). He drew a very instructive map of the system of protection of Human Rights in China, using several case studies related to the issues of access to land and food.

Colloquium on the vegetal - Lyon, December 9th, 2011 :

Organized by the « Louis JOSSERAND laboratory » of the University Jean Moulin Lyon 3, this [colloquium](#) brought together many specialists to discuss and present the different ways to apprehend the vegetal from a legal perspective. During this day, Professor François COLLART DUTILLEUL addressed the issue : « the vegetal and international food safety ».
