On July 1st, members of the Lascaux Program gathered to prepare for the **seminar to be held in Quebec, Canada on September 5th and 6th, 2011**. On this occasion, they deepened the fundamental concepts that will guide the

work of the research project in the coming months, and they connected these concepts to the different subjects of doctoral thesis of the PhD students. This work, which will continue throughout the summer, will allow the team to participate in the many debates that will be held during the meeting in September.

We would also like to remind you that the **XXVI European Congress on rural law** will take place in Bucarest from September 21st to 24th, during which a questionnaire and a report on "Agriculture and the requirements of sustainable development" will be presented, written by several members of the Lascaux Program.

Finally, an international Symposium on the Law of Foreign Relations to the European Union will be co-organized by Lascaux and the DCS Laboratory at the Faculty of Law of Nantes on November 24th and 25th, 2011.

The prevailing famine in the Horn of Africa has been quite topical for the past weeks.. The FAO has had the opportunity to point out **the massive production of biofuels leading in particular to the overexploitation of soils** as one of the main origins of this famine . But these are not the only identified causes : **drought in this region and the proliferation of conflict areas** strongly aggravate situations of famine and **the States Etats are struggling to stem this crisis.**

In this regard, the FAO launched last July an online campaign for public consultation **on food security and nutrition** .
