Doctoral seminar on property in Lyon - April 6th, 2012 :

This seminar will be co-organized by the [Ecole Doctorale de droit de l'Université de Lyon Jean Moulin](#) and the Lascaux Program and will address the issue of [the relationship between property and goods](#). Several presentations and round tables will take place during the day that will give the researchers an opportunity for studying the various aspects of property, both from a national and international point of view.

From **March 12th to March 16th**, Lascaux will have the pleasure to receive the visit of Professor **Jane M. GLENN** from McGill University, Montreal (Canada). She will share with the team her expertise and knowledge on property law, land tenure, urban planning and agricultural law.

Seminar on public order and fundamental rights, Bayonne, January 17th, 2012 :

The seminar « [Fundamental rights, public order and economic liberties](#) » co-organized by the [CDRE](#) and Lascaux brought together several eminent Professors, among which **Horatia MUIR WATT** from Sciences-Po Paris, **Alain BERNARD** and **Fabrice RIEM**, from the University of Bayonne, **Gonzalo SOZZO** from the Universidad Nacional del Litoral in Santa Fe (Argentina) and **François COLLART DUTILLEUL** from the University of Nantes (and Director of Lascaux).

Together they discussed the possible role of legal concepts such as public order or *Jus Cogens* in the promotion of human rights (especially the fundamental right to food) and the implementation of international economic and financial legislation.

Conference on food and food taboos between Jews, Christians and Muslims in the Middle Ages, February 6th, 2012 (MSH Ange Guepin - Nantes) :

This conference was the second part of the cycle « [Besoins fondamentaux : Réexamen des concepts](#) » co-organized by Lascaux and [Relmin](#) projects. It revolved around the fundamental links between food practices and habits and identity formation from the Vth to the XVth centuries.
