TerrEthique Conference at the Académie d'Agriculture de France, Paris, September, 20th, 2012 :

Upon the invitation of [TerrEthique](#), association, Professor **COLLART DUTILLEUL** will hold a conference on the legal issues relating to food safety and will present the objectives of Lascaux Program.

Conference « Against hunger, let us be consistent », Paris October 4th, 2012 :

François **COLLART DUTILLEUL** and Thomas **BRÉGER**, post-doctoral researcher for Lascaux, will take part in a conference co-organized by the [CFSI](#) and the [Agence Française du Développement](#). Through the prism of food security and the right to food for Southern countries, the participants, among which Mr Stéphane **HESSEL** (Honorary Chairman of the CFSI, Ambassador of France, co-editor of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights), will discuss the coherence between the European Union's development policies and its extraterritorial obligations regarding human rights.

Lascaux's international events, from November 6th to 30th, 2012 :

Between November 2012 and November 2013, Lascaux will launch an important round of international events. The objective is to discuss and define with the actors of civil society the appropriate ways to legally ensure food security. Throughout November 2012, a number of public conferences, scientific seminars and film screenings will be organized by the Lascaux Program and its local and national partners. The publication [De la terre aux aliments, des valeurs au droit](#), which compiles a number of contributions from Lascaux's 2009 and 2010 forums, and the Spanish version of the [Code de droit européen de l'alimentation](#), were issued in August 2012 by **INIDA** publishing house.

The Code was conducted under the supervision of **François COLLART DUTILLEUL** (Professor of Law at the University of Nantes and Director of Lascaux) and **Paul NIHOUL** (Professor at the Université Catholique of Louvain).

The English and Dutch versions will be published in September 2012, by Brylant and Larcier respectively.
